2. ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

2.1 Introduction

The Indira Gandhi National Open University was established by an Act of Parliament in 1985 to achieve the following objectives:

- democratizing higher education by taking it to the doorsteps of the learners
- providing access to high quality education to all those who seek it irrespective of age, region, religion and gender
- offering need-based academic programmes by giving professional and vocational orientation to the courses
- promoting and developing distance education in India
- Setting and maintaining standards in distance education in the country as an apex body.

2.2 Prominent Features

IGNOU has certain unique features such as:

- international jurisdiction
- flexible admission rules
- individualized study: flexibility in terms of place, pace and duration of study
- use of latest information and communication technologies
- nationwide student support services network
- cost-effective programmes
- modular approach to programmes
- resource sharing, collaboration and networking with conventional Universities, Open Universities and other Institutions/Organizations
- socially and academically relevant programmes based on students need analysis
- convergence of open & conventional education systems

2.4 The Schools of Studies & Centers

2.5 Academic Programmes

The University offers both short-term and long-term programmes leading to Certificates, Diplomas, Advance Diploma, Associates Degree and Degrees, which are conventional as well as innovative. Most of these programmes have been developed after an initial survey of the demand for such Programmes. They are launched with a view to fulfill the learner's needs for:

- certification,
- improvement of skills,
- acquisition of professional qualifications,
- continuing education and professional development at work place,
- self-enrichment,
- diversification and updation of knowledge, and
- Empowerment.

2.6 Course Preparation

Learning material is specially prepared by teams of experts drawn from different Universities and specialized Institutions in the area spread throughout the country as well as in-house faculty. The material are scrutinized by the content experts, supervised by the instructors/unit designers and edited by the language experts at IGNOU before these are finally sent for printing. Similarly, audio and video cassettes are produced in consultation with

the course writers, in-house faculty and producers. The material is previewed and reviewed by the faculty as well as outside experts and edited/modified, wherever necessary, before they are finally dispatched to the students, Study Centres and Telecast through Gyan Darshan.

2.7 Credit System

The University follows the 'Credit System' for most of its programmes. Each credit in our system is equivalent to 30 hours of student study comprising all learning activities (i.e. reading and comprehending the print material, listening to audio, watching video, attending counseling sessions, teleconference and writing assignment responses). Thus, a 4-credit course involves 120 hours of study and 6-credit course involves 180 hours of study. This helps the learner to know the academic effort he/she has to put in, to successfully complete a course. Completion of an academic programme (Degree or Diploma) requires successful completion of the assignments, practicals projects and the term-end examination of each course in a programme.

2.8 Support Services

In order to provide individualized support to its learners, the University has a large number of Study Centres, spread throughout the country. These Study Centres are co-ordinated by 60 Regional Centres and Recognized Regional Centres. At the Study Centres, the learners interact with the Academic Counsellors and other learners, refer to books in the Library, watch/listen to video/audio programmes and interact with the Coordinator on administrative and academic matters. The list of Regional and Study Centres is given in this handbook. Support services are also provided through Work Centres, Programme Study Centres, Skill Development Centres and Special Study Centres.

2.9 Programme Delivery

The methodology of instruction in this University is different from that of the conventional Universities. The Open University system is more learner-oriented and the learner is an active participant in the pedagogical (teaching and learning) process. Most of the instructions are imparted through distance education methodology and face-to-face mode as per the requirement.

The University follows a multimedia approach for instruction, which comprises:

- a) **Self Instructional Written Material:** The printed study material (written in self-instructional style) for both theory and practical components of the programmes is supplied to the learners in batches of blocks for every course (on an average 1 block per credit). A block which comes in the form of a booklet usually comprises 3 to 5 units.
- b) **Audio-Visual Material Aids:** The learning package contains audio and video CDs which have been produced by the University for better clarification and enhancement of understanding of the course material given to the learners. A video programme is normally of 25-30 minutes duration. The video cassettes are screened at the study centres during specific sessions which are duly notified for the benefit of the learners.
The video programmes are telecast on National Network of Doordarshan and Gyan Darshan. All Gyan Vani stations are broadcasting curriculum based audio programmes. In addition, some selected stations of All India Radio are also broadcasting the audio programmes. Learners can confirm the dates for the programmes from their study centres. The information is also provided through the university website.
- c) **Counselling Sessions:** Normally counselling sessions are held as per schedule drawn by the Study Centres. These are held on weekends that is, Saturday and Sunday. There will be 6 counselling sessions of 2½ hours duration for each course in face to face (F2F) mode, apart from tele-counselling sessions at Gyan Darshan-II, as per announced schedule.
- d) **Gyan Darshan and Gyan Vani Educational Channels**
 - i) **Gyan Darshan:** Gyan Darshan is a satellite-based educational TV channels which was started on 26th January, 2000. It carries not only the educational videos of IGNOU, but also those of other major educational organizations like the UGC, CIET-NCERT, NIOS, IITs, TTTIs and also developmental and cultural programmes intended for the public at large. Operating through a C-band transponder on INSAT 3C as a free-to-air channel on a round the clock basis, the channel has been upgraded as a completely digital channels with effect from 26th January, 2003.

In its present digital configuration, the Gyan Darshan bouquet offers the following channels:

GD-1 : The main educational channel catering to all sectors of education.

GD-2 : Interactive channel consisting of live teleconferences, telecounselling sessions etc.

GD-3 : Technology education channel consisting of programmes pertaining to engineering topics. The programmes are sourced from various IITs.

GD-4 : The fourth channel in the bouquet of Gyan Darshan Channels, Vyas brings quality education to the students pursuing higher education.

Provision also exists for starting some more channels, planned to be dedicated to agriculture, vocational education and school education respectively.

The Gyan Darshan channels can be accessed through a local cable operator or through a dish antenna equipped for digital reception on C-band from INSAT 3C (downlink frequency: 4165 MHz. Symbol rate: 26000).

ii) Gyan Vani: Conceived as a joint venture between MHRD and IGNOU, the Gyan Vani project comprises a network of 40 FM Educational Radio Stations located in different places across the country. Thirty seven of these stations are already operational.

Each Gyan Vani radio station caters to a service area of around 60 km radius and can be received on normal FM radio sets. The programming mainly aims at local educational needs in the local language. The help of local educational institutions and educationists is sought in programme production. Live programmes with phone-in interactivity are a notable feature of Gyan Vani stations, which are particularly popular with the student population.

(iii) Interactive Radio Counselling: This is a phone-in programme which is conducted live across the country every Sunday between 4 and 5 PM and is relayed by all AIR stations. Resource persons present in the studio explain the topic of the day after which a live question-answer session follows. Students from some select cities in the country can phone in by using a toll free number (16001-12345) and get their doubts cleared in real time. These phone-in counselling sessions are a boon to distance education students as they provide the much needed interactivity and human touch.

e) Practicals Work: The course CITL-001: Laboratory Course have practical component also. Practicals are held at designated institutions for which schedule is provided by the Study Centres. Attendance at practicals is compulsory.

Term-end Examination and Payment of Examination Fee

The University conducts Term-end Examination twice a year in the months of June & December. Students will be permitted to appear in term-end examination subject to the conditions that 1) registration for the courses, in which they wish to appear is valid, 2) minimum time to pursue these courses is elapsed, and 3) they have also submitted the required number of assignment(s), if any, in those courses by the due date.

Students can also submit on-line examination form as per guidelines through IGNOU website at www.ignou.ac.in.

Examination fee @ Rs. 60/- per course is required to be paid either through online payment gateway, cash deposit on designated banks and also through demand drafts.

2.10 On-Demand Examination

The University has a scheme of Associate Studentship

The Facility of On-Demand Exams

IGNOU provides facility of On-Demand examination to its bonafide and eligible students to appear for examination in several courses as per their convenience and preparation without waiting for six monthly term-end examination. If for any reason a student failed at or failed to appear at term-end examination or needs to clear any course for career advancement or any other kind of progress before the next available term-end examination, he/

she may register for On-Demand Examination On-line from anywhere at any time. The facility of On-Demand Exam is available at selected Regional Centres of IGNOU in different parts of the country.

5. CERTIFICATE IN BUSINESS SKILLS (CBS)

This Programme "Certificate in Business Skills" is developed jointly by IGNOU, Rajiv Gandhi Foundation (RGF) and Commonwealth of Learning (COL) Vancouver, Canada. The main objective of this programme is to enable NGOs and other agencies to develop business skills among the street children, unemployed youth, rural and urban disadvantaged sections and women, so that these groups can avail gainful self employment opportunities. This is a vocational programme, as it gives more emphasis to self employment. This certificate programme make the learners competent in the areas of business communication, entrepreneurship, basic computer knowledge, business organization and accounting. The salient features of this programme are as follows :

5.1 Salient Features of CBS

- Courses designed and prepared by professional expert.
- Student centered multimedia learning materials.
- Strong students support services.
- Opportunity to interact with leading experts through the teleconferencing.
- Student can study at their own chosen place and not required to attend regular classes.
- Student can study at his own pace and convenience over a period of 6 months to 2 years.
- Student is exposed to vocational/professional expertise.
- Students have the opportunity to develop skills in computers.
- Teaching is done through an innovative multi-medium.

5.2 CBS Programme Structure

The University follows the credit system for its Certificate in Business Skills programme. Each credit amounts to 30 hours of study comprising all learning activities. Thus, a 4-credit course involves 120 study hours and 6 credits involves 18 courses of study. To successfully complete the CBS programme, you will have to earn 18 credits over a period of 6 months to 2 years depending on your convenience. This Programme has the following four compulsory courses of four credits each:

1. ECO-1: Business Organisation	4 Credits
2. PCO-1: Preparatory Course in Commerce	4 Credits
3. BCOA-001: Business Communication and Entrepreneurship	4 Credits
4. CITL - 001 Laboratory Course	6 Credits

5.3 Eligibility for Admission

Candidates who have qualified 10+2 or its equivalence from any recognised university are eligible for admission to this CBS Programme.

5.4 Duration of the Programme

The Programme has been designed for a minimum duration of 6 months. A student once admitted, his/her registration is valid for two years. Thus, a student can complete this programme within a minimum period of 6 months or a maximum period of two years. In case of failure to do so, student will be required to seek re-admission by paying prescribed programme fee.

5.5 Medium of Instruction

The programme is offered in English medium. Printed course materials are sent to the students in English.

5.6 Fee Structure

The programme fee for this CBS programme (including Registration fee is **Rs. 1900/- (Rupees One thousand nine hundred only)**). The programme fee should be paid only by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of IGNOU payable at the city where your Regional Centre is situated. Please write in capital letters **your name, address** and the **Programme** to which the admission is sought to ensure proper credit to your fee account. Fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.

CITL-001: LABORATORY COURSE

The basic objective of this course is to develop the skills so that the student can use the Computer in day to day applications. It covers the aspects of loading the Operating System as well as writing small 'C' programs. After studying this Course, the learners would be able to install Windows & Linux, develop and run basic 'C' programs, do word processing, develop presentations, work with databases, create small programs using HTML and design web pages.

For CITL001, there shall be 18 practical sessions consists of 3 hours each. A student needs to attend at least 12 out of 18 practical counseling sessions (each session is of 3 hours duration) to become eligible to appear for Term End Practical Examination in CITL001. 6. PROGRAMME DELIVERY

The methodology of instruction in this University is different from that of the conventional Universities. The open university system is more learner-oriented and the learner is an active participant in the teaching and learning process. Most of the instructions are imparted through distance education methodology rather than

face-to-face communication. The University follows a multimedia approach for instruction. It comprises of the following components.

6.1 Self-learning Print Material

The Printed material for all the courses is mailed to the students by post. On an average, each course comprises of 2 to 4 blocks. A block which comes in the form of a booklet comprises of 3 to 5 units. These printed materials are prepared by in-house faculty with the help of teams of experts drawn from conventional universities, management institutions and professional managers from all over the country. These materials are again edited by the subject experts, and language experts at IGNOU before they are finally sent to the press for printing. These books are different from normal text books. They are specially developed in self instructional design to facilitate the distance learner.

6.2 How to Study Print Material

The print material prepared by the university is self instructional in nature. Each course has been divided into a number of Blocks. Each Block consists of a number of Units (lessons). Normally, all the units covered in one block have a thematic unity. The first page of each block indicates the contents of each block i.e., the number and titles of the units covered in that block. This is followed by a brief introduction to the block. This block introduction explains the total coverage of the block as a whole as well as the coverage of each unit in that block.

Each unit is structured to facilitate self study for you. The section on **Objectives** briefly states what we expect you to attain when you have completed the unit. In **Introduction**, there is an attempt to forge a link with the topics of the previous units and the topic to be covered in the present unit. This is followed by the main body of the unit, which is divided into various sections and subsections. In the main body there are a few self-check exercises under the caption **Check Your Progress**. Enough space is given for you to write your answers to the questions set in the self-check exercises. Answers to these exercises are given in the section **Answers to Check Your Progress Exercises** at the end of the unit.

The section **Let Us Sum Up** summarises what has been said in the whole unit. This summary enables you to recall the main points covered in the unit. To facilitate comprehension, important words/terms covered in the unit are explained in the section **Key Words**. Some books for additional reading are suggested in the section **Some Useful Books**. For your reference purpose some of these books may be available in the study centre. The section **Terminal Questions/Exercises** is intended to give you an idea about the nature of question that may be asked in term end examinations. **These question and Check Your Progress Exercises are for your practice only, and you should not submit answers to these questions to the University for assessment.**

Read the units carefully and note down the important points. You can use the space in the margin of the printed pages for making notes and writing your comments. While reading the units mark the words that you do not fully understand. Look for the meaning of such words under the section **Key Words** or in a dictionary. Read the unit again and again until you have understood the point. You may also try to find it in earlier units as it may be explained there. However, if you still do not understand something, consult your counsellor during the face-to-face sessions at the Study Centre for clarification.

Try to answer '**Check Your Progress**' questions. These exercises will help you to reinforce the information/ knowledge you gain through your first reading of the text. Proper comprehension of the units and the points/ notes made by you while reading through the units would help you in answering the **Check Your Progress Exercises** given in the units. Once you have written the answer in the blank space provided for each question, you can compare your answers with the answers given in the section '**Answers to Check Your Progress Exercises**'.

6.3 Counselling Sessions

Normally counselling sessions are held as per a schedule drawn before hand by the Coordinator of your study centre. They are normally held on weekend, (Saturday and Sunday) of the week. There will be 10 counselling sessions of 2-1/2 hours duration for each course in face to face at your study centre and some additional sessions per course through teleconference mode. The purpose of counselling is to answer some of your questions and clarify your doubts which may not be possible through any other means of communication. It is also intended to

provide you an opportunity to meet your fellow students. There are experienced academic counsellors at the study centres to provide counselling and guidance to you in the courses you have chosen for study. The counselling sessions for each of the courses will be held at suitable intervals throughout the whole academic session. The counselling sessions are not compulsory. However, they may be very useful in certain respects such as: to share your views as the subject with counsellors and fellow participants, comprehend some of the complex ideas or difficult issues, and get clarification for many doubts which you would not otherwise try to raise and consult academic counsellors for selecting courses of study.

Face-to-face counselling will be provided to you at the study centre assigned to you. You should note that the counselling sessions will be very different from the usual classroom teaching or lectures. Counsellors will not be delivering lectures or speeches. They will try to help you to overcome difficulties (academic as well as personal) which you face while studying. In these sessions, you must look into the subject-based difficulties and any other issues arising out of such difficulties. Besides, the audio and video cassettes will also be played in the counselling sessions.

Before you go to attend the counselling session, please go through your course materials and note down the points to be discussed. Unless you have gone through the units, there may not be much to discuss. Try to concentrate on the relevant and the most important issues. Also try to understand each other's points of view, without making the session a seminar or a debate. You may also establish personal contact with your fellow participants to get mutual help for academic purposes. Try to get the maximum possible help from your counsellors.

6.4 Practical Sessions for CITL – 001

Practical sessions for the CITL – 001 course will be held in computer centre, which may or may not be co-located with your CBS programme study centre. Your concerned Regional Centre will allocate the centre for the CITL – 001 course to attend practicals and counselling sessions. For successful completion of this course a minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory in the practical sessions. coordinator(s) of the study centre may organize suitable number of 'make-up' sessions for students who miss out the mandatory attendance requirements. Details of the practical sessions is given below :

Evaluation system for this course in CBS should be the same as in CIT. Evaluation system for this course comprises of continuation evaluation through assignment with 25% weightage and Term-end practical examination with 75% weightage.

As part of continuous evaluation, a student has to attempt one assignment for 25 marks. There will be a Term End Practical Examination of three hours duration for a maximum of 50 marks. Term End Practical Examination will consist of 2 Questions. The first question will cover the areas under Lab Manual-1 and the second question will cover areas under Lab Manual-2.

A student must secure 40% marks in continuous evaluation as well as term end examination for the successful completion of this course.

6.5 Audio-Visual Material Aids

The learning package contains audio and video cassettes which have been produced by the university for better clarification and enhancement of understanding of the course material given to the learner. A video programme is normally of 25-30 minutes duration. The audio tapes are run and video cassettes are screened at the study centres during specific sessions which are duly notified for the benefit of the learners. The video programmes are telecast on National Network of Doordarshan and Gyan Darshan. Some of the selected stations of All India Radio are also broadcasting the audio programmes. Learners can confirm the dates for the programme from their study centres. The information is also provided through the National Newspapers and IGNOU Newsletters sent to the learners periodically.

6.6 Telecounselling

Telecounselling is a satellite based interactive system capable of carrying one-way video and two-way audio communication. The university is arranging lectures by senior faculty and outside experts in the studio at head-

quarters and students can watch these programmes LIVE on TV sets arranged at all IGNOU regional centres and selected study centres. After the presentation by the experts, students can ask questions through the phone or fax and the expert will give clarifications and attend to all queries. In fact, it is simulation of class room situation through TV. The receive sites for these teleconferencing have been set up all over the country for the benefit of the students. All the Regional Centres and selected study centres are the receive sites of IGNOU.

6.7 Interactive Radio-Counselling

Interactive Radio-Counselling is a recent concept in distance learning in India. Live counselling is provided on radio by invited experts. Students can ask questions right from their homes on telephone. These sessions are conducted for an hour on Sundays from 189 radio stations in the country. A toll free telephone number 1600 112345 has been provided for this purpose from selected cities.

6.8 Gyan Darshan Educational Channel

A collaboration between MHRD, Prasar Bharti, IGNOU and other organisations has resulted in launching DD Gyan Darshan, the Educational Channel of India. In a significant gesture, EMPC has been identified as the coordinating and transmitting agency. Regular transmission of educational programmes from the EMPC studios started on January 10, 2000. The Channel is providing educational programme on a variety of subjects for 24 hours a day to enhance the learning process. Steps are being taken to relay the Gyan Darshan Channel through different Cable Operators in the Country for wider outreach. GD signals can be conveniently received without any special equipment anywhere. Gyan Darshan has now gone completely digital and expanded into a bouquet of channels namely GD-1, GD-2 and GD-3 'Eklavya'. Educational programmes are contributed by major educational institutions such as IGNOU, UGC/CEC, NCERT/CIT, Directorate of Adult Education, IITs and other educational/development organizations in the country. Gyan Darshan transmissions uplinked from the earth station of EMPC-IGNOU, New Delhi can be accessed all over the country throughout the year and round the clock without any break.

6.9 Gyan Vani

IGNOU has been offered FM Channel Radios in 40 cities and towns for education and development. EMPC is the nodal agency for implementing the project. EMPC is also studying an experimental proposal for global Gyan Vani. As many as 17 FM Radio Stations at Allahabad, Bangalore, Coimbatore, Vishakhapatnam, Mumbai, Lucknow, Bhopal, Kolkata, Chennai and Delhi are already on air. The broadcasts in English, Hindi and the regional languages/dialects are conducted by local resource persons. The detailed schedule can be accessed at IGNOU EMPC-Gyandarshan Website <http://www.ignou.ac.in/gyandarshan%scindex.html>.

7. EVALUATION SYSTEM

- 1) The Evaluation for each course covers two aspects :
 - a) Continuous evaluation through assignments (Tutor Marked Assignment (TMAs)/ Computer Marked Assignment (CMAs).
 - b) Term-end examinations.

In the final results all the assignments of a course carry 30% weightage while 70% weightage is given for term-end examination.

- 2) All the assignments and term-end examinations will be scored as a numerical marking scheme. Any component, which has not been attempted would be treated as having a score of 0 (zero) marks.
- 3) To claim Certificate in Business Skills (CBS), the requirement for pass would be at least 35% marks (Grade D) in both continuous evaluation (assignments) as well as term-end examination of each course except computer courses (CILT-001). **Candidate should keep in mind that the minimum pass percentage for CILT-001 is 40%. You must note this difference in the evaluation system for this computer course.** The scores of continuous evaluation and term-end examination are not complementary to each. The above condition is mandatory for all courses of CBS programme.

- 4) Depending on the percentage of marks secured by a candidate, the divisions will be awarded as follows:

1st Division	-	60% and Above	Pass	-	35% to 49.9%
IInd Division	-	50% to 59.9%	Unsuccessful	-	Below 35%

To claim Certificate in Business Skills, the requirement for pass would be at least 35% marks (Grade D) in term-end examination and in assignment separately of each course except CITL-001 course in which pass percentage is 40%. Depending on the percentage of marks secured by a candidate, the divisions will be awarded as follows:

1st Division	-	60% and Above	Pass	-	40% to 49.9%
IInd Division	-	50% to 59.9%	Unsuccessful	-	Below 35%

University follows grading system for continuous evaluation as well as term-end examination. It is done on a five-point scale using letter grades, A,B,C,D,E. The university has decided to provide numerical marking also in the grade card and award of division for CBS Programme.

The notional correlates of the letter grades and percentage of marks are as under:

Assignments – Instructions

Assignments constitute the continuous evaluation. The submission of assignments is compulsory. The marks that you get in your assignments will be counted in your final result. For the 3 courses other than CITL-001, assignments of a course carry 30% weightage while 70% weightage is given to the term-end examinations. For CITL-001, continuous evaluation carry 25% weightage and TEE carry 75% weightage. Therefore, you are advised to take your assignments seriously. A simple omission on your part may cause loss to you and inconvenience at all levels in the University.

You have to complete the assignment within the due dates specified in the assignments booklet or within one month of the date of receipt of assignments whichever is later. You will not be allowed to appear for the term-end examination for any course if you do not submit the specified number of assignments in time for that course. If you appear in term-end examination, without submitting the assignments the result of term-end examination would be liable to be cancelled.

You will not be allowed to appear for the term-end examination for any course if you do not submit assignment in time for that course.

The main purpose of assignment is to test your comprehension of the learning materials you receive from us and also to help you get through the courses. The evaluators/counsellors after correcting the assignments send them back to you with their comments and marks. The comments guide you in your study and help in improving it. The content provided in the printed course materials should be sufficient for answering the assignments. Please do not worry about the non-availability of extra reading materials for working on the assignments. However, if you have easy access to other books, you may make use of them. The assignments are designed in such a way as to help you concentrate mainly on the printed course materials and exploit your personal experience.

There are two types of assignments: i) Tutor Marked Assignments (TMA) which are evaluated by the counselor, and ii) Computer Marked Assignments (CMA) which are evaluated by the computer.

Whenever you receive a set of material and assignment, check them immediately and ask for missing pages, if any, from Material Production and Distribution Division, IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi - 110 068.

The assignment responses should be complete in all respects. Before submission you should ensure that you have answered all the questions in all assignments. Incomplete answer sheets bring you poor grades.

The University/Co-ordinator of the Study Centre has the right to reject the assignment submitted after the due date. You are, therefore, advised to submit the assignment before the due date.

For your own record, retain a copy of all the assignment responses which you submit to the Coordinator. If you do not get back your duly evaluated tutor marked assignments along with a copy of assessment sheet containing comments of evaluator on your assignment within a month after submission, please try to get it personally from your study centre.

This may help you to improve upon future assignments. Also maintain an account of the corrected assignment responses received by you after evaluation. This will help you to represent your case to the University in case any problem arises.

In case of tutor-marked assignments, you have to submit your response sheets to the Coordinator of the Study Centre assigned to you. After evaluation these tutor marked assignments will be sent back to you with comments and marks (grade). The computer-marked assignment is to be sent directly to the Registrar, Student Registration and Evaluation, Indira Gandhi National Open University, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi - 110068.

Do not forget to get back your duly evaluated tutor marked assignments alongwith a copy of the assessment sheet containing comments of the evaluator on your performance. This may help you to improve future assignments.

If you do not get pass grade in any assignment, you have to submit it again. To get fresh assignments you should write to Registrar, MPDD, IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi - 110068. However, once you get the pass grade in an assignment, you cannot re-submit it for improvement of grade. Assignments are not subject to re-evaluation except for factual errors, if any, committed by the evaluator.

The discrepancy noticed by you in the evaluated assignments should be brought to the notice of the Coordinator of the Study Centre, so that the correct score is forwarded by him to the Student Registration and Evaluation Division at Headquarters. Score communicated by the study centre through any mode other than the award list will not be acceptable to the university for taking your score of assignments on your record.

In case you find that the score indicated in the assignment sheet of your Tutor marked assignment has not been correctly reflected or is not entered in your grade card, you are advised to contact the coordinator of your study centre with a request to forward correct award list to the SR&E Division at the Headquarters.

Do not enclose or express doubts for clarification if any about study material or assignment alongwith the assignment. Send your doubts in a separate cover to the Director of the concerned School at IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi 110 068. Give your complete enrolment number, name, address, title of the course, and the number of the Unit or the assignment, etc. on top of your letter.

- 1) Write your Enrolment Number, Name, Full Address, Signature and Date on the top right hand corner of the first page of your response sheet.
- 2) Write the Programme Title, Course Code, Course Title, Assignment Code and Name of your Study Centre on the left hand corner of the first page of your response sheet.

- 3) Read the assignments carefully and follow the specific instructions, if any given on the assignment itself about the subject matter or its presentation.
- 4) Go through the Units on which assignment is based. Make some points regarding the question and then rearrange those points in a logical order and draw up a rough outline of your answer. While answering an essay type question give adequate attention to introduction and conclusion. The introduction must offer your brief interpretation of the question and how you propose to develop it. The conclusion must summarise your response to the question. Make sure that the answer is logical and coherent, and has clear connections between sentences and paragraphs. The answer should be relevant to the question given in the assignment. Make sure that you have attempted all the main points of the question. Once you are satisfied with your answer, write down the final version neatly and underline the points you wish to emphasise. While solving numericals, use proper format and give working notes wherever necessary.
- 5) Use only foolscap size paper for your response and tie all the pages carefully. Avoid using very thin paper. Allow a 4 cm margin on the left and at least 4 lines in between each answer. This may facilitate the evaluator to write useful comments in the margin at appropriate places.
- 6) Write the responses in your own hand. Do not print or type the answers. Do not copy your answers from the Units/Blocks sent to you by the University. If you copy, you will get zero marks for the respective question.
- 7) Do not copy from the response sheets of other students. If copying is noticed, the assignments of such students will be awarded zero.
- 8) Write each assignment separately. All the assignments should not be written in continuity.
- 9) Write the question number with each answer.
- 10) The completed assignment should be sent to the Coordinator of the Study Centre allotted to you. Under any circumstances do not send the tutor marked response sheets to the Student Registration and Evaluation Division at Head Quarters for evaluation.
- 11) After submitting the assignment at the Study Centre get the acknowledgment from the Coordinator on the prescribed assignment remittance-cum-acknowledgment card.
- 12) In case you have requested for a change of Study Centre, you should submit your Tutor Marked Assignments only to the original Study Centre until the change of Study Centre is notified by the University.
- 13) If you find that there is any factual error in evaluation of your assignments e.g. any portion of assignment response has not been evaluated or total of score recorded on assignment response is incorrect you should approach the coordinator of your study centre for correction and transmission of correct score to headquarters.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPUTER MARKED ASSIGNMENTS

- 1) At the end of each computer marked assignment (CMA), you find the response sheet. You have to write your answers on that response sheet. The details of Programme Code, Course Code and Assignments Code are printed on the response sheet. Therefore, you should be very careful to use the response sheet only for the same assignment. By mistake, if the response sheets of two different assignments are interchanged, all the answer may become wrong and may result in a poor grade. So, you are advised to tear off the response sheet from the assignment only after completing the answers and other particulars.
- 2) Proforma of the CMA response sheet is enclosed in this programme guide for your information. If you have missed or misplaced the response sheet of any assignment, you can use the photocopy of the proforma given in this programme guide. Please note that the details of Course Code and Assignment Code are left blank. So, you should carefully fill up these columns whenever you use the photocopy of this proforma.
- 3) Write your enrolment number carefully in the prescribed column. Any mistake in the enrolment number will lead to non-declaration of your result. Also write your name and address clearly in capital letters in the prescribed columns.
- 4) Put your signature and date of submission of response sheet in the columns prescribed.
- 5) In the response sheet you can see the question numbers printed from 1 to 50. Below each number you can find blank box which is meant for writing the answer.
- 6) For each question in the assignment four answers are provided, of which only one answer is correct. You have to read the question carefully and select the correct answer. Then write the number of the correct

answer in the box provided for that question in the response sheet. For example assume Questions 1 and 2 in the assignment are as follows:

Q.1 The urban revolution took place in the:

- a) It Iron Age
- b) Neolithic Age
- c) Paleolithic Age
- d) Bronze Age

(The right answer here is the alternative given at number 4.)

Q.2 The British Policy of divide and rule:

- a) Created communal harmony in India
- b) Had no impact at all
- c) Created communal division
- d) Helped no one

(The right answer here is the alternative given at number 3.)

Now you have to choose the correct answers for these questions. The correct answer for Q.1 is the alternative given in 4. So you have to write 4 in the box below question 1 in the response sheet. Similarly, correct answer to Q.2 is the alternative given in 3. So write 3 in the box below Q.2 in the response sheet. This is shown below:

- 7) If you think that none of the answer is correct for a specific question, write 0 in the box related to the question. Similarly, if you do not want to answer any question, put a (x) in that box.
- 8) Do not over-write on the answer because such an answer may not be legible and may not be accepted. Therefore, write your answers on the response sheet only when you are absolutely sure of it.
- 9) You should not fill in the columns provided for office use at the bottom of the response sheet.
- 10) Retain a copy of duly filled CMA response sheet for your record purpose.
- 11) After completing the assignment, tear off the response sheet from the assignment put it in an envelope and mail it to the following address:

- 12) If you find that the score of your CMA is not reflected in your grade card, please send a copy of the CMA response sheet for verification to the evaluation Division at the headquarter along with a documentary evidence of having sent the CMA to the evaluation division at the headquarters.

8. TERM-END EXAMINATION

8.1 Term-end Examination

As stated earlier, term-end examination is the major component of the evaluation system and it carries 70% weightage in the final result.

The University conducts term-end examination twice a year i.e., in June and December. You can take the examination only after completion of the course, failing which you can take the same in December or June of subsequent years within the total span of the programme.

In case you fail to get a pass score in the Term-end Examination, you will be eligible to reappear at the next Term-end Examination for that course as and when it is held, within the total span of the programme.

Eligibility for Examination

To be eligible to appear at the Term-end Examination in any course, you are required to fulfil the following four conditions.

- 1) You should have paid the registration fee.
- 2) You should have opted and pursued the prescribed course.
- 3) You should complete the submission of assignments for the respective course.
- 4) You should submit the examination form with a fee of Rs. 50 per course in time (which is explained later).

8.2 Examination Date Sheet

Examination date sheets (Schedule which indicates the date and time of examination for each course) are sent to all the Study Centres approximately 5 months in advance. The same is also notified through IGNOU News Letter from time to time. Thus, normally, the date sheet for June examinations is sent in the month of January/February and for December examination in the month of July/August. You are advised to see whether there is any clash in the examination dates of the courses you wish to take i.e. examination of any two courses you wish to take are scheduled on the same day at the same time. If there is any clash, you are advised to choose one of them in that examination and the other course in the next examination (i.e., June or December as the case may be).

8.3 Examination Form

It is an essential pre-requisite for you to submit the Examination Form along with examination fee of Rs. 50 per course through draft, in favour of IGNOU payable at New Delhi for taking examination in any courses. The examination forms are available at Study Centres/Regional Centres/Student Registration and Evaluation Division at Headquarters and you may also download from INTERNET www.ignou.ac.in. A specimen copy is also printed here in this Programme Guide. However, **you cannot take photocopy of this form for use**. Only one form is to be submitted for all the courses in one term-end examination. If you do not submit your form within the specified time, you have to pay late fee as mentioned below.

The filled in examination form along with examination fee of Rs. 50 per course through draft is to be sent to the Registrar, SR&E Division, Indira Gandhi National Open University, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi-110068 only, but not to any other office. Please mention your name and enrolment number on reverse side of the draft. The last date for submission of examination forms are 1st March to 31st March for the examination to be held in June, and 1st September to 30th September for examinations to be held in December. The last dates for receipt of examination forms after the due date with a late fee in addition to the normal fee, as under:

* During these dates, submit the exam form with the requisite fee to the concerned Regional Centre for outside Delhi students. For Delhi Region, submit to the Registrar, SR & E, New Delhi. Examination for these students will be conducted at the respective Regional Centre City only.

Dates are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances to be notified.

Please write your correct enrolment number, programme code and name at the back of the Demand Draft/IPO drawn in favour of IGNOU, New Delhi for Rs. 100/500/1000 representing late fee along with normal fee i.e., Rs. 60/- per course and properly tag with your examination form to avoid its misplacement. The examination form received after due dates without late fee, wherever applicable, shall be rejected.

8.4 Admit Card

After receiving the examination forms from you, the University will send admit card to you before the commencement of examination. If you do not receive the admit card 15 days before the commencement of examinations, you may contact your Study Centre or Regional Centre or Student Registration and Evaluation Division at the Headquarters. If your name is registered for examinations in the list sent to the Study Centre, even if you have not received admit card or misplaced it, you can take the examination by showing your Identity Card (Student Card) to the examination centre superintendent.

Every student must bring identity card for appearing in term end examination along with the admit card.

8.5 Examination Centre

Your Study Centre is normally your examination center. The University at its discretion may allot you any examination centre other than your study centre. Change of examination centre is not generally permitted. In exceptional cases change of centre may be considered. For this students should apply one month in advance to Registrar, SR&E at IGNOU. Your enrolment number is your Roll Number for examinations. Be careful in writing it. Any mistake in writing the Roll Number will result in non-declaration of your result.

8.6 Declaration of Result

It is your duty to check whether you are registered for that course and whether you are eligible to appear for that examination or not. If you neglect this and take the examination without being eligible for it, your result will be cancelled.

Although all efforts are made to declare the result in time, there will be no binding on the University to declare the results of the last examination before commencement of next examination. You are therefore, advised to fill up the form without necessarily waiting for the result and get it cancelled at a later date if so required.

No student is allowed to reappear in an examination for improving the marks after successfully passing it.

Study Centre is the contact point for you. The University cannot send communication to all the students individually. All the important communications are sent to the Coordinators of the Study Centres and Regional Directors. The Coordinators would display a copy of such important circular/notification on the notice board of the Study Centre for the benefit of all the Students. You are, therefore, advised to get in touch with your Coordinator for day-to-day information about submission of examination forms, date-sheet, list of students admitted to a particular examination, declaration of result, etc. While communicating with the University regarding examination, please clearly write your enrolment number and complete address. In the absence of such details, we will not be able to attend to your problems.

8.7 Re-evaluation of Answer-Scripts

There is a provision of re-evaluation of term-end examination's answer-scripts. To avail this facilities, the request should be made on the prescribed form along with a draft of Rs. 300/- per course drawn in favour of IGNOU payable at New Delhi and the same by submit/sent to the Registrar, SR& E Division, IGNOU, New Delhi - 110 068 by Registrar post. Please write your name, enrolment number, centre code at the back of the demand draft.

The request for re-evaluation by the students must be made before 31st March for December TEE and 30th September for June TEE or within one month of declaration of results, whichever is later. The date of declaration of results will be calculated from the date on which the results are placed on the IGNOU website.

After re-evaluation, the better of the two scores of original marks and re-evaluation marks will be considered. The revised marks shall be incorporated in the student record and the revised Marks sheet shall be sent to the students within one month from the receipt of the application.

9. OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

9.1 IGNOU Newsletter

The University publishes newsletter two times in a year in English as well as in Hindi. It is mailed to the students free of cost. All the important information relevant to the students is published in the newsletter.

9.2 Reservation of Seats

The University provides reservation of seats for scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, other backward classes, wards of defence personnel who lost their lives or were seriously injured and physically handicapped students as per the Government of India rules.

9.3 Scholarships and Reimbursement of Fees

Reserve categories viz., scheduled caste/scheduled tribe other backward classes and physically handicapped students, have to pay the fees at the time of admission to the University along with other students.

Physically Handicapped students admitted to IGNOU are eligible for Government of India scholarships. They are advised to collect the scholarship forms from the Directorate of Social Welfare or Office of the Social Welfare Officer of the concerned State Government and submit the filled-in forms to them through the concerned Regional Director of IGNOU. Similarly for reimbursement of programme fees, SC/ST students have to submit their forms to the Directorate of the Social Welfare or Office of the Social Welfare Officer of the respective State Government through the concerned Regional Director of IGNOU.

9.4 Change/Correction of Address

There is a printed card for the change/correction of address. This card is normally sent to you along with the study material, a copy of the same is given in this programme guide. In case there is any correction or change in your address, you are directed to make use of that printed card addressed to your concerned Regional Director (e-mail is not entertained).

The Regional Office verify your signature from the original records and forwarded the same to the Registrar, SR&E, IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi-110068 for further necessary action. You are advised not to write letter to any other officer in the University, except to your concerned Regional Director in this regard. Normally, it takes four to six weeks to effect the change. Therefore, you are advised to make your own arrangements to redirect the mail to the changed address during this period. The form for this purpose is available in this programme guide for Xerox or you can also download form IGNOU website.

9.5 Change of Study Centre

The candidates are required to opt only such study centres which are activated for the programme. As far as possible the university will allot the study centre opted by the candidate. However, the university may change the study centre at its convenience without concurrence of the student at any time.

For the purpose of change of Study Centre, you have to send request to the Director of your Regional Centre. A copy of the same may be sent to Student Registration and Evaluation Division at the headquarters.

Counselling facilities for a programme may not be available at all the Centres. As such you are advised to make sure that counselling facilities are available for the programme you have chosen, at the new Centre opted for. As far as possible the request for change of Study Centre is considered favourably. However, the allotment of new Study Centre is subject to availability of seats for the programme at the new Centre asked for.

9.6 Change of Regional Centre

When you want transfer from one Region to another Region, you have to write to that effect to the Regional Centre from where you seek a transfer marking copies to the Regional Centre where you would like to be transferred to and also to Registrar (SRD), New Delhi. Further, you have to obtain a certificate from the

Coordinator of the Study Centre from where you are seeking transfer regarding the number of assignments submitted, The Regional Director from where you are seeking the transfer will transfer all records to the Regional Centre where you seek transfer under intimation to you and Registrar (SRD). The records are normally sent by Registered Post to guard against loss in the postal transit.

9.7 Issue of Duplicate Grade Card/Mark Sheet

A duplicate Grade Card is issued after a request is made on the prescribed form along with a draft of Rs. 25/- to be paid in favour of IGNOU, New Delhi. The form for the purpose is given in this Programme Guide.

9.8 Re-admission

If you are not able to complete the programme in a maximum of 2 years, University has made a special provision for readmission. The form and the guidelines are available in this Programme Guide. Kindly fill and submit it as per instructions.

9.9 Simultaneous Registration

A student is permitted to register for only one programme in the given academic session. You are, therefore, and advised to seek admission to only one programme in the given academic session. Violation of this rule attracts cancellation of admission to all the programmes and forfeiture of the programme fees.

9.10 Refund of Fees

Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. It is also not adjustable against any other programme of this university. However, in case university denies admission the programme fee will be refunded after deduction of registration fee through account payable cheque only.

9.11 Migration Certificate

For Migration Certificate, requisition may be sent to the Regional Director alongwith the following documents:

- 1) Application (can be obtained from the Head Office or photocopy of the one given in programme guide could be used.)
- 2) Attested copy of the marksheet.
- 3) Fee of Rs.100/- in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of IGNOU payable at the city where Regional Centre is located.

Samples of various forms currently used in the University are provided in this Programme Guide. Whenever you need any of these please take a photocopy, fill it and send it to us.

9.12 Credit Transfer

Definitions

"Credit transfer" means allowing a student of another university to get admitted to IGNOU for completing any equivalent degree/diploma programme on the basis of credits obtained by him/her from that University. A student thus admitted need to write IGNOU examinations for such courses which are found equivalent to for which appropriate credits would be deemed to have been acquired for and purposes for fulfilling the IGNOU requirements for award of a degree/diploma.

Eligibility

The credit transfer scheme is applicable only to those candidates who have not completed their degree from any other recognized University yet willing to complete through IGNOU as per rules provided.

Modalities

- 1) All credit transfers should be allowed in case where students have done some courses but have not completed the programme and have not got certification.
- 2) Normally credit transfer will be applicable only from a diploma, bachelor's degree, master's degree to an equivalent diploma, bachelor's degree and a post graduate degree.
- 3) Credit transfer will be permissible only in the case of students coming from institutions established by an Act of Parliament or by an Act of State Legislature; or an institution "deemed to be university" or an "institution of national importance" or institutions recognized by statutory bodies like AICTE, ICMR, ICAR, CSIR etc.
Credit transfer can be done only on the basis of individual courses and not on the basis of year to year courses as in conventional institutions.
- 5) In order to get a diploma/degree from IGNOU a student will be required to earn at least 50% credit from IGNOU. For example, a B.Com/B.A./B.Sc. Student should earn at least 48 credits from IGNOU for an IGNOU degree.
- 6) The degree certificate or the marks list thus given to the students will specifically indicate the credits earned in IGNOU and those obtained from other institution.

No credit transfer be allowed for the courses for which a certification has been done for another programme. However, for those who come through module programme the credits may be carried along to the higher level from the lower one by surrendering the certificate.

Rules and Regulations for Credit Transfer

- 1) Student who want to avail credit transfer shall get registered with IGNOU for the programmes they want to study. All the applications for credit transfer should invariably be addressed to Dy. Registrar, SR&E, IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi-110068.
- 2) The students have the choice to opt the electives of second year in the first year and 3rd year in second year of their studies.
- 3) The students by opting the courses in such a way to complete the balance credits, can reduce the period of study prescribed for the completion of the degree programme and thereby avail no payment of fees to the period not covered. The students availing credit transfer would be allowed to complete the programme early provided they do not offer more than 32 credits in a year.
- 4) IGNOU "programmes" and "Courses" means "subjects" or "papers" respectively of conventional universities.
- 5) Students seeking credit transfer should apply directly to the Dy. Registrar (SRD) IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi - 110068 enclosing a Demand Draft for Rs.-50/- per course drawn in the name of IGNOU and payable at New Delhi, attested copies of Marks sheet and attested copies of syllabus of such courses, covered by them. The Equivalence committee at the Headquarters of the university will examine such cases separately. This process will take a minimum period of three months from the date of receipt of such requests with all the relevant documents by the above concerned officer.

9.13 Disputes on Admission and Other University Matters

The place of jurisdiction for filing of a Suit if necessary will be only at New Delhi/Delhi.

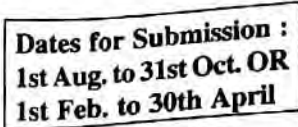
